- Remember the Gospel daily (Not Just Once When You Were Saved).
- The Gospel isn't a doorway we walk through once — it's the air we keep breathing.
- Practice regular, honest self-examination.
- The person who is aware of their own sin will rarely feel superior to others.
- Confess sin quickly and specifically.
- Confession shrinks pride because it prevents us from maintaining an image of ourselves that is not true.
- Treat every person as someone Jesus died for.
- Grace is humiliating before it is liberating.
- It tells the truth about us in a way that pride cannot survive.
- Grace reveals that we contributed nothing to our salvation.
- Grace exposes us as deeply needy, not impressive.
- Grace begins where our strength ends.
- Grace makes us dependent, not self-reliant.
- Grace shifts our identity from performance to position.
