 - How does God's faithfulness affect your view of His promises?
 - When did you see God's faithfulness on display in your life?
 - How does God's immutability impact your appreciation of God's faithfulness?
- Read James 1:17 & Psalm 34:8
 - How can reflecting on God's goodness change our perspective on life?
 - How does God's goodness impact our peace when things are chaotic around us?
- Read 1 Thessalonians 5:23
 - What does finding peace in God actually look like?
 - How can understanding God's peace bring comfort during difficult times?
- Read Romans 11:33
 - Why is God's wisdom important to our understanding of His character? How should it affect us?
 - What does Godly wisdom look like over worldly wisdom?
 - Where can you find God's wisdom?
- Read Lamentations 3:22-23 & Psalm 145:8
 - How do mercy and grace reflect God's character?
 - Why are mercy and grace essential to our relationship with God?
