- Restoration begins when we identify that the offended one has the right to be offended and full authority to restore or not restore.
- Mercy – withholding what is rightly deserved.
- Forgiveness and restoration are based solely on the heart, character, and goodness of the one offended.
- Restoration is grounded in the character of the offended One.
- Restoration requires ownership and personalizing of the offense.
- Sin is an affront to the nature of God.
- Restoration asks for a release from deserved punishment.
- The result is praise because of the action of the one who forgave.
- This kind of forgiveness requires one very difficult work – humility.
