- God's nature is personal.
  - God doesn't just want obedience — He desires relationship.
  - The Gospel is relational at its core.
  - A personal God means personal care.
  - God's care is intimate, detailed, and constant.
  - Prayer becomes conversation: “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.” (Philippians 4:6)
  - Scripture becomes personal: “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” (Psalm 119:105)
  - Worship becomes relational: “God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.” (John 4:24)
  - Obedience becomes trust: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.” (John 14:15)
